FOREST HILLS COUNTRY CLUB RULES OF PLAY

- The USGA's The Rules of Golf applies except where noted.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR IS:
 - Defined by white circles on the golf course.
 - Newly sodded or stripped areas.
 - Bunkers under construction; if a small area of the bunker is under construction then only that area is considered ground under repair.
 - Both old and new irrigation trenches and french drains.
 - Nurseries, decorative flower beds, and small trees with mulch around them.
- OUT OF BOUNDS is defined by the inside edge of white stakes at ground level. All subdivision roadways are out of bounds. A ball that crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the golf course. The exception to this is the subdivision road in front of the 9th tee on the Valley Course; one must cross this road in order to play the hole.
- The following are considered OBSTRUCTIONS: (See Rule 24)
 - Artificially surfaced cart paths.
 - Bridges, wooden steps and paths.
 - Sprinkler heads and yardage markers.
 - Culvert covers and irrigation control boxes.
 - STONES IN BUNKERS are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1). The stones may be removed or, if the ball lies in or on the stone, the ball may be lifted, the stone removed and the ball shall be dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay, not nearer the hole.
- Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes and/or lines. Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes and/or lines. There is a designated DROP AREA which may be used on Hole #16. On Holes #5, 12 & 14, you may drop at the front of the forward tees.
- If a ball strikes the wires on Hole #7 or 14, it must be replayed with no penalty assessed. The towers and supporting structures are considered obstructions; a ball striking these is played as it lies, a "rub of the green."
- In case of lightning, 3 short yelps of the siren will sound. Clear the course immediately marking the position of your ball.
